



PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of Hurston Lane, Storrington and Sullington CP, 16th February 2026.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic, Hurston Lane, Storrington and Sullington CP, in the Horsham District under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Hurston Lane for a distance approx 689 metres.

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 16th February 2026 for up to 5 days (it is estimated to be completed on 20th February 2026) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Trooli undertakes a 24hr/day road closure between the junctions with Pulborough Road and Hurston Lane to Fryern Road to access BT boxes for desilting, gullysucking, proving, cabling and splicing.

The restriction will be in place **24hrs/day**
